

OUTSTANDING LEADER AWARD (Service Unit Level)

The Outstanding Leader Award recognizes troop/group leaders, assistant troop/group leaders, or group coordinators whose performance in working with girls is so outstanding that it merits recognition by the geographic or program delivery unit.

Criteria:

1. The candidate is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The candidate has completed appropriate training, or has demonstrated competence in girl-adult partnership, communication, membership development, pluralism, and program delivery.
3. The candidate's work with girls has exceeded expectations for the position as outlined in the job description or agreement.

Nomination:

An individual or group familiar with the candidate's performance submits an application or narrative account of the candidate's accomplishments to the geographic or program delivery team or to the council recognition's task group. The application outlines how the service performed as benefited girls.

Troop/group members or their families or both submit two letters of endorsement describing the outstanding leadership qualities of the candidates and how the girls have benefited.

Approval:

The geographic or program delivery team or the recognition's task group reviews the information, approves or denies the nomination, and notifies the nominating individual or group.

Form of Recognition:

The Outstanding Leader Award is a pin depicting a leadership torch against a yellow background. It is worn on the right side of the uniform, below the personalized identification pin, or on either side of the Years of Service pin. If an adult has received more than one special recognition, e.g., Appreciation Pin or Honor pin, the last one received is generally the one worn on the uniform.

A certificate is also available to be presented along with the pin.
