

OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER AWARD (Service Unit Level)

The Outstanding Volunteer Award recognizes an adult in a position other than leader or in addition to leader whose service benefits a geographic or program delivery unit in a way that is beyond the expectations for the position.

Criteria:

1. The candidate is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The candidate has completed appropriate training, or demonstrated competence for the job, or both.
3. The candidate has performed at a level that exceeds the expectations of the position as outlined in the job description agreement.

Nomination:

An individual or group familiar with the candidate's performance submits an application or narrative account of the candidate's accomplishments to the geographic or program delivery team or to the council recognition's task group.

Approval:

The geographic or program delivery team or recognition's task group reviews the information, approves or denies the nomination, and notifies the nominating individual or group.

Form of Recognition:

The Outstanding Volunteer Award is a pin depicting a white chain and gold trefoil against a red background. It is worn on the right side of the uniform, below the personalized identification pin, or on either side of the Years of Service pin. If an adult has received more than one special recognition, e.g., Appreciation pin or Honor pin, the last one received is generally the one worn on the uniform.

A Certificate is also available to be presented along with the pin.

Note: The Outstanding Volunteer Award differs significantly from the Appreciation pin only in the level of approval required. This encourages increased recognition of volunteers at the area level and provides greater flexibility in the council's adult recognition system.
